



ROOF SURFACES

A. High Priority - Roof surface should be replaced as well as possibly roof structure. Opportunity for green roof surface to reduce thermal gain & slow stormwater runoff.

B. Medium Priority - Roof surface should be replaced. Opportunity for green roof surface to reduce thermal gain & slow stormwater runoff.

C. Low Priority - May be altered by exteriors group. Does not cover interior space. Does protect exterior door from water damage.

D. High Priority - Roof surface should be replaced & new sloped insulation should be installed to fix drainage & add insulation value.

E. Medium Priority - Roof surface may not have to be replaced. Opportunity to have a white elastomeric coating applied to lengthen the life of the membrane & reduce thermal gain.

F. Low Priority - Nothing May have to be done.

G. Low Priority - Nothing May have to be done.

H. Low Priority - New roof addition.
